

**VILLAGE OF YELLOW SPRINGS, OHIO  
RESOLUTION 2006-23**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE GREENE COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE VILLAGE OF YELLOW SPRINGS AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY A SPECIFIED NUMBER OF MILLS.**

**WHEREAS**, the amount of taxes which will be raised with the ten-mill limitation will not be sufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Village of Yellow Springs, Greene County, Ohio, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council may request the voters to approve a rate not to exceed 8.4 mill general tax levy in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of continued operation of community facilities, providing for needed capital improvements, and other operational needs, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council is required to certify to the Greene County Auditor a resolution requesting the total current tax valuation of the Village and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a specified number of mills.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF YELLOW SPRINGS, OHIO HEREBY RESOLVES THAT:**

**Section 1.** It is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the benefit of the Village of Yellow Springs for the purpose of raising money for the current expenses of the Village at a rate not exceeding 8.4 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 84 cents for each \$100.00 of valuation, for a five-year period of time commencing in 2006, first due in calendar year 2007. This levy will run for five years.

**Section 2.** The question of levying additional taxes shall be submitted to the electors of the Village at the general election to be held at the usual voting places within the Village on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of November 2006.

**Section 3.** The levy shall be placed on the tax list of the current year if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

**Section 4.** The Greene County Auditor is hereby requested to certify to the Village of Yellow Springs the total current tax valuation of the Village and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the number of mills specified in Section 1 hereof.

**Section 5.** The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify a copy of the Resolution to the Greene County Auditor's Office and to the Greene County Board of Elections and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

**Section 6.** This Resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
