VILLAGE OF YELLOW SPRINGS WATER QUALITY INFORMATION

Village staff tests our water daily to ensure proper chlorine residual levels in the distribution system. Staff also conducts weekly samples for bacteria, iron and manganese. The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio OEPA) requires numerous other tests for nitrates, nitrites, inorganics, synthetic organic compounds, volatile organic compounds, lead and copper.

If you have questions about the water you receive from the Village, you may refer to the Consumer Confidence Report that the Village publishes each year by July 1.

This report contains information about source water, contamination, and drinking water regulations.
