**SUPPORTING THE HEALTH AND WELFARE OF OUR YOUTH AND ENCOURAGING GREENE
COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO PURSUE STATEWIDE LEGISLATION**

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Yellow Springs is deeply concerned about the health and welfare of our youth; and

WHEREAS, it has been found that the use of tobacco and other products severely impacts the lung health of the users of those products, as well as of those in proximity to such users; and

WHEREAS, it has been found that the earlier the use of such products begins, the more potent the ill effects may be; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Yellow Springs has already proactively limited the use of tobacco products in our public spaces; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Yellow Springs strongly supports statewide legislation that would encompass the population of the State of Ohio and, thereby, promote the health and welfare of all of our young people;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Village of Yellow Springs does hereby

Section 1. Encourage and support the Greene County Department of Health to work with other county departments of health in lobbying our State legislators to enact such legislation Statewide.

Section 2. Encourage all citizens and businesses to take action showing their support of such an initiative by contacting their State legislators regarding same.
