**1450.01 ESTABLISHMENT AND BOUNDARIES OF FIRE DISTRICT
NO. 1.**

There is hereby established a fire limit in the Village to be known as Fire District No. 1, the boundaries of which are as follows: any area which is now zoned Industrial or Business or which shall be zoned as such in the future.

**1450.02 ESTABLISHMENT AND BOUNDARIES OF FIRE DISTRICT
NO. 2.**

There is hereby established a fire limit within the Village to be known as Fire District No. 2, the boundaries of which are fixed as follows: all the area within the Village not included in Fire District No. 1.

**1450.03 CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS IN FIRE DISTRICT
NO. 1.**

All buildings or structures, other than for family use or domestic occupation, hereafter erected within Fire District No. 1, shall meet the requirements of the Ohio Basic Building Code, as adopted in Chapter 1422.

**1450.04 CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS IN FIRE DISTRICT
NO. 2.**

All buildings or structures for family occupation or domestic use hereafter erected within Fire District No. 2 shall meet the requirements of the OBOA One, Two and Three Family Dwelling Code, as adopted in Chapter 1420. All repairs or alterations to any existing building in Fire District No. 2 must conform to the requirements of such Code.

1450.99 PENALTY.

Whoever violates any of the provisions of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree and shall be fined not more than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) or imprisoned not more than thirty days, or both, for each offense. A separate offense shall be deemed committed each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.
