# REPEALING SECTION 1248.03 "SPATIAL REQUIREMENTS" OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF YELLOW SPRINGS, OHIO AND ENACTING NEW SECTION 1248.03 "SPATIAL REQUIREMENTS"

Whereas, Codified Ordinance Section 1248.03 of the Village of Yellow Springs, Ohio provides the spatial requirements for residential zoning districts; and

Whereas, Village Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to adopt a new Section 1248.03 entitled õSpatial Requirementsö of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Yellow Springs, Ohio to update the dwelling unit destiny in the R-B zoning district to conform with other sections of the Codified Ordinances,

## NOW, THEREFORE, COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF YELLOW SPRINGS, OHIO HEREBY ORDAINS THAT:

**Section 1.** Section 1248.03 entitled õSpatial Requirementsö of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Yellow Springs, Ohio be repealed in its entirety.

**Section 2.** A new Section 1248.03 entitled õSpatial Requirementsö of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Yellow Springs, Ohio be enacted to read as set forth on Exhibit A with new language <u>underlined</u> and **bolded** and deleted language in <del>strikethrough</del>, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

**Section 3**. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest date permitted by law

#### Exhibit A

#### 1248.03 SPATIAL REQUIREMENTS.

(a) All lots and buildings shall meet the minimum area and width requirements of Table 1248.03. New lots shall not be created, except in conformance with these requirements.

R-A, Low-Density Residential	7,500	60				
R-B, Moderate-Density Residential	6,000 <sup>2</sup>	50				
R-C, High-Density Residential	<b>4,800</b> <sup>3</sup>	40				

- 1 Public water and sanitary sewer is required for all property in these districts.
- 2 Two-family and attached single-family dwellings shall provide 4,500 square feet per unit. Multi-family dwellings are permitted a density up to 148 units per acre.
- 3 Two-family dwellings shall provide 4,000 square feet per unit. Attached single-family and multi-family dwellings are permitted a density up to 14 units per acre.
- (b) All structures and their placement on a lot shall conform to the minimum dimensional requirements listed in Table 1248.03a.
