New Business:

- **ACC-Sponsored Public Art - Summer Piano Project.** Conception: Three pianos are placed at selected locations in the downtown area. A sign indicates that people are invited to play the pianos. The pianos are donated. They will not be expected to be returned. Individuals and/or businesses will volunteer to cover the pianos with tarps when it rains. A piano tuner (paid or volunteer) will be scheduled for occasional caretaking. The pianos could be painted for visual effect. Some type of seating is provided. The pianos will be returned, given away or disposed of when the project ends. Budget - ACC possible costs: piano moving, sinage, tarps, tuners, paint... (J. Fleming)
