**AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO APPLY FOR A FEMA GRANT
APPLICATION FOR BUILDING RESILIENT INFRASTRUCTURE AND

WHEREAS, the Village of Yellow Springs, has aged electrical infrastructure in need of upgrades and replacement, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Yellow Springs desires financial assistance under the Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) program to shift away from reactive disaster response and towards proactive investment in building community resilience by upgrading power lines, pole replacement and undergrounding select electrical services.
