

**VILLAGE OF YELLOW SPRINGS, OHIO
RESOLUTION 2020-20**

**OFFICIAL QUESTION AND ISSUE BALLOT-GENERAL ELECTION-NOVEMBER 3, 2020
PROPOSED TAX LEVY (RENEWAL)**

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which will be raised with the ten-mill limitation will not be sufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Village of Yellow Springs, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2020 Council for the Village of Yellow Springs, Ohio (“Council”) passed Resolution 2020-19, which requested the Greene County Auditor certify the total current tax valuation of the Village of Yellow Springs and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a specified number of mills, and

WHEREAS, Council has agreed to levy a renewal tax for the purpose of raising money for the current expenses of the Village at a rate not exceeding 8.4 mills for each one dollar of valuation which amounts to 84 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five years, commencing in 2021, first due in calendar year 2022, and

WHEREAS, the question of levying taxes for the general fund shall be submitted to the electors of the Village at the general election to be held at the usual voting places within the Village on the 3rd day of November, 2020,

NOW, THEREFORE, COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF YELLOW SPRINGS, OHIO HEREBY RESOLVES WITH TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

SECTION I. Council has received certification issued by the County Auditor for Greene County, Ohio, pursuant to Section §5705.03, as amended, of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION II. The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Village of Yellow Springs.

SECTION III. It is necessary to levy a renewal tax in excess of said ten (10) mill limitation for, as stated in Section 5705.19(A), as amended, of the Ohio Revised Code, the purpose of current expenses of the Village at a rate not exceeding 8.4 Mills, which is a renewal of an existing levy of 8.4 mills, for each One Dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, which amounts to Eighty-Four Cents (\$0.84) for each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of valuation, for a five (5) year period of time.

SECTION IV. Said levy shall be submitted to the electors of this Village at the primary election to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, and at the regular place or places of voting within this Village as established by the Board of Elections of Greene County, Ohio during the election hours established by state law or by said Board of Elections.

SECTION V. The form of the ballot to be used at said election shall be substantially as follows:

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage

A renewal tax for the benefit of the Village of Yellow Springs, Ohio for the purpose of the current expenses of the Village at a rate not exceeding 8.4 Mills, which is a renewal of an existing levy of 8.4 mills, for each One Dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, which amounts to Eighty-Four Cents (\$0.84) for each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of valuation, for a Five (5) year period of time, beginning in the year 2021, and first due in calendar year 2022.

SECTION VI.

If a majority of the qualified electors of this Village voting thereon vote in favor thereof, the levy shall be placed upon the tax list and duplicate of the then current year of 2021 (the proceeds of which levy first would be available for collection in the calendar year of 2022).

SECTION VII.

The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections of Greene County, Ohio, not later than four o'clock (4:00) pm on the ninetieth (90th) day before the date of said election and to notify the Board of Elections of Greene County, Ohio, to cause notice of the election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

SECTION VIII.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including, but not limited to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IX.

Pursuant to Section 5705.19, as amended, of the Revised Code, this Resolution shall go into immediate effect upon its passage, and no publication of the resolution is necessary other than that provided for in the notice of election.
