# Why Now?

- •Central area in the community
- Often neglected
- •Significant interest from Citizens and Community Groups to see BH Park play a more central role in physical, social and community life of YS.

# Beatty-Hughes Park:

- •We are an aging community,
- •We are a diverse community
- •We are committed to using lessons of Covid to improve our health and well being
- •We have serious storm water issues
- •Park is semi-derelict and significantly under used.



# Purpose:

- •Build accessible access to park from Senior Center
- •Develop programs to strengthen connections among groups, like using Park for outdoor movies sponsored by 365 Project, use newly built pavilion for community concerts, art exhibits, and performances
- •Use landscape principles to encourage a sense of calm and principles from therapeutic gardens to encourage plant/people interactions, universal designs, and intergenerational interactions.
- •Storm water remediation including a water garden to

Work Plan: Two – Three Years:

- •Secure formal approvals and complete bidding and hiring of landscape designer
- Complete land and tree surveys
- •Complete draft design and submit for community input
- •Complete "hard scape" features
- Prepare ground for landscaping
- Obtain plants
- •Work with partners and develop programs and maintenance plan
